KHES provides a small group, called The Good Grief Club, which supports children coping with the death of a loved one. The Good Grief Club will meet every other Friday from 2:30-3:15 in Mrs. Kennedy's office, starting on Friday, January 13th and continuing through Friday, April 21st.

Who is eligible for the group?

- Any child who has experienced the death of a significant person in his/her life: parent, sibling, grandparent, friend, or anyone else with whom the child was close.
- The death could have occurred at any time – recently or years ago. (As children mature cognitively, they sometimes revisit the loss and show signs of early grief again.)

Student pick-up will be in back carpool line. Parents should pick-up their student no later than 3:30. Students who attend the YMCA will be escorted over after group.

Parents need to sign permission forms for students to participate in the group; Mrs. Kennedy can send the forms home with your child, so please let her know if your child is interested in participating.
